The only thing you have left to complete your skill set is more surface turns (multiples), toe turns, and line steps. I'd like to see you work those into your arsenal in the coming seasons. Great season. I was thinking of a nickname for you. I keep coming up with The Silent Knight, because you rarely speak, but you always come ready for battle.
Daniel	Lariviere	Good idea for the intro but a bit long (more than 1/3rd of the video). The fast play in the car made me nauseous and the right side pass on the highway was not necessary, especially that there was nobody in the left lane. It is one thing to risk injuring yourself, but you should not risk injuring others. Intro aside, the video is well edited and very entertaining. The choice of music is good and the song changes work great with the pace of the video. Lots of different camera angles, I enjoyed the shots taken from another boat. Trick wise, I especially liked the one foot hops. Crashes at the end remind us that it is not as easy as it looks... <i>NOTE: Nolan's pass on the shoulder is common in Texas. The car in front of him was turning left and we make our shoulders wide for that purpose.</i>
